

I-5 Paving & Signs Project

Capitol Highway to Lombard Street

Fact Sheet
Spring 2015

Project Overview

The Oregon Department of Transportation is starting work on Interstate 5 from SW Capitol Highway to N. Lombard Street. The work consists of two components:

- » **Sign Replacement:** Beginning in March, many of the green highway signs on I-5 from SW Corbett Avenue to N. Lombard Street and on both decks of the Fremont Bridge (I-405) will be replaced. Existing signs will be updated to meet federal standards. The new signs will feature more reflective materials and a less cluttered design, making them easier to read.
- » **Paving:** Starting this spring, approximately seven miles of roadway on I-5 between SW Capitol Highway and the Marquam Bridge will be repaved. The pavement, last replaced in 2004, is deteriorating and needs to be repaired. Transitions to on-ramps and off-ramps will also be paved and improvements will be made to several bridges.

Construction is scheduled to be complete by the end of the year, but is weather dependent and subject to change.

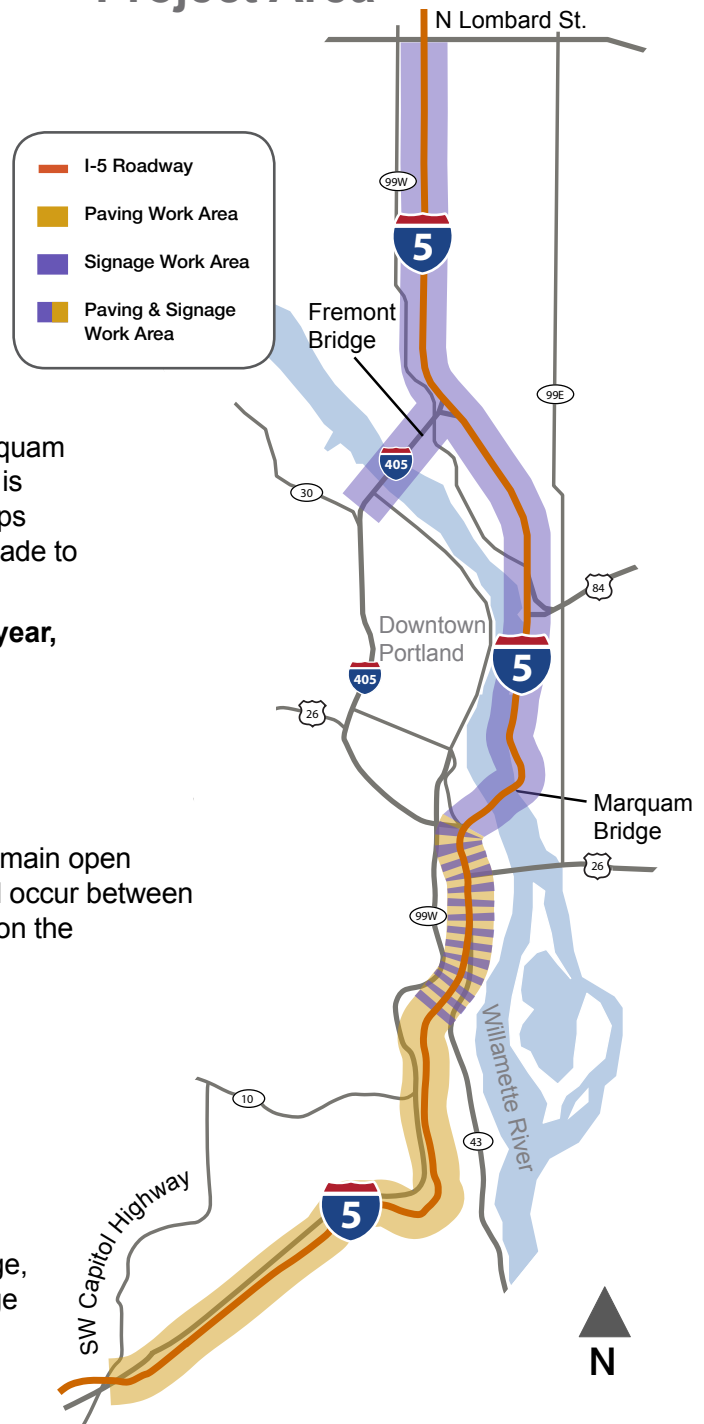
All Lanes and Ramps Open During The Day

To reduce impacts to motorists, all lanes and ramps on I-5 will remain open during the day and construction will take place at night. Work will occur between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. on weekdays and between 8 p.m. and 9 a.m. on the weekends. Daytime shoulder closures on I-5 may occur.

Nighttime Closure Information

- » Signage work will require multiple full closures of I-5 on the east side of the river, as well as full closures of the Marquam Bridge (I-5) and Fremont Bridge (I-405).
- » When I-5 is closed, traffic will detour to I-405. When I-405 is closed, traffic will detour to I-5.
- » The entire project area, including south of the Marquam Bridge, will have lane and ramp closures to accommodate the signage and paving work. Some exits will have temporary overnight closures.
